Members of Kings Way volunteered with ShareFest to spruce up Flemming High School.

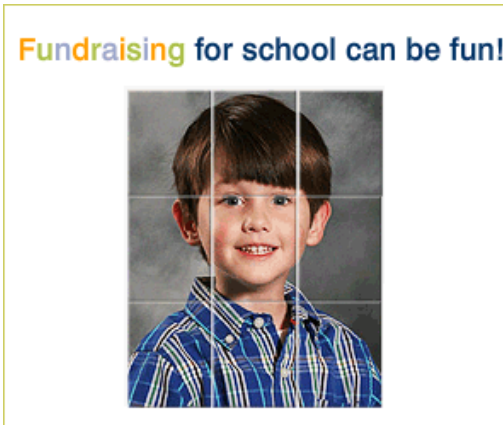
Volunteers from Harbor City helped with the distribution Food Bank provided to Harbor Village residents. Harbor Village celebrated their 10th anniversary on the same day.
